

#SONIASDREAM SENIOR PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION DEADLINE: May 15th, 2024

VALUE: TBA

WHERE TENABLE: Any recognized institution granting earned degrees at the postsecondary level or professional training program in the applicant's field of study and located in Canada. Can be put towards Seymour Dance programs.

LEVEL OF STUDY: Post-secondary research or another study with a Canadian postsecondary or professional institution for Performing Arts (such as Harbour Dance).

FIELD OF STUDY: Any Fine Arts, including but not limited to dance, theatre, and music.

CRITERIA: Applications will be evaluated on the quality of the proposed programme and an essay outlining the qualifications of the applicant to complete the programme and the potential of the programme to further the individual's performance. The applicant must indicate his or her reasons in their essay for pursuing the Fine Arts and how/if they plan to give back to their community through and/or after their studies. (Maximum 1,000 words)

CONDITIONS: The candidate must:

- 1. Be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.
- 2. Have completed a minimum of **500 hours** from Seymour Dance with competitive and/or RAD achievement/involvement.
- 3. The candidate must submit their portfolio (as described below) by the link on our scholarship page on our website.

AN APPLICANT'S PORTFOLIO CHECKLIST:

1) Essay (Maximum 1,000 Word Count)
2) 3 Photos of the Candidate dancing (video footage optional)
3) Table/chart outlining completed hours at Seymour Dance
